Some of the benefits of an internship with WAMU are:

- The internship is paid at \$15 per hour and can be full-time or part-time.
- Our interns don't fetch coffee; they are an integral part of a working team. Our interns are involved in pitching, writing and producing for their teams, often with on-air and online attribution.
- We provide a structured curriculum that includes information sessions and one-on-ones with staff from all departments as well as time at NPR headquarters to provide insight and understanding of all aspects of our industry. We believe that in order to be successful in any industry, you need to understand how all aspects of that industry work. We try to provide that for our interns.
- After someone completes an internship at WAMU, they often end up working for us or for other high-profile media organizations. An internship at WAMU is genuinely a point of entry for a career in journalism and media.
